We are looking forward to caring for you. If you are here for your annual wellness exam, here's what you can expect for services — and when extra charges may apply.

What's Included in Your Annual Exam

- Review of health history, medications, family history, and vital signs
- Breast exam
- External genital exam
- Vaginal exam and Pap smear (Pap billed separately)
- Bi-manual exam (uterus and ovaries)
- Contraception counseling
- General wellness and preventive care review

What's Not Included—Billed Separately

- Pap smear, HPV testing
- STD testing (chlamydia, gonorrhea, HIV, etc.)
- · Immunizations and injection fees
- Lab work (plus blood draw fee)
- Ultrasounds or procedures

Services That May Result in Additional Charges

If you discuss or treat new health issues at your annual wellness exam, you may be billed for both an annual wellness exam and a problem-oriented office visit.

- Acute concerns (UTI, vaginitis, sudden concerns)
- Chronic disease management (hypertension, diabetes, thyroid, asthma, allergies)
- · Mental health support (anxiety, depression, ADHD, sleep issues)
- Medication management (dose adjustments, refills requiring medical decision-making)
- Symptom-driven evaluation (chest pain, fatigue, abnormal bleeding, headaches, abdominal pain, shortness of breath)
- Minor procedures (lesion removal, biopsy may include lab/pathology charges)

We advise patients to talk about coverage with their insurance provider.
